
C3 & GRASSROOTS SERVICE INITIATIVES - \$26,370

C3 is the administrative and organizational engine behind everything that we do. While we continue to rely heavily on volunteers, Stacy Smith serves part-time to provide administration, accounting, volunteer coordination, and ministry development for everything under the C3 umbrella. In addition to staffing costs, our administrative budget includes office expenses, professional fees, and taxes incurred by all our initiatives. Our board members approve each initiative we undertake, and all our grassroots efforts are led by at least one of our directors.



PIONEER - \$2,500

Pioneer hosts weekly meetings and classes for people in recovery. From 12-Step meetings in local churches and Bible study offerings at recovery facilities and homeless shelters, Pioneer reaches thousands of lives each year. Monthly expenses include retreat sponsorships, shuttling expenses, and supplies for weekly meetings.



C3 PUBLISHING - \$3,000

C3 Publishing supports the development and production of revenue-producing original works such as books, music, and curriculum that emphasize Christ-following spiritual formation. In 2026, we anticipate beginning a new manuscript tentatively entitled *Unvangelical*.



PILATES FOR PARKINSON'S - \$3.600

Pilates for Parkinson's partners with Diane Renz and *Corehaus* in offering Pilates and movement-based classes to help those living with Parkinson's in the greater San Antonio area. Through the charitable giving of our partners, we offer reduced rate scholarships for Pilates classes to those needing financial assistance.
